Dear Parents/Carers,

<u>Year 10 Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award – Assessment Expedition</u> <u>Saturday 13th and Sunday 14th June 2020</u>

Your Son/Daughter has been working towards their Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award this past year and we are getting close to them completing all their sections. Students will have completed their practice expedition in Stillington and Husthwaite during May. This letter details the preparation for the assessed expedition which is taking place over two days and includes an overnight camp. This assessment takes place on **Saturday 13**th **and Sunday 14**th **June 2020** and all students need to complete this expedition as part of their award. There will be numerous teachers including myself who will be with the students during the weekend. During the day they will be remotely supervised in teams whilst out navigating.

The expedition starts on Saturday morning until Sunday afternoon and the format is exactly the same as the practice expedition. We will be **camping at Lakeside Holiday Park, Castle Howard, YO60 7DA.** Campsite is about 30 minutes' drive from the Vale of York Academy.

To keep costs as low as possible we are **asking parents to drop students off and collect students from The Highwayman Pub, The Square, Sheriff Hutton, York YO60 6QZ by 9.30 am on Saturday 13th June and to collect around 3.30 pm on Sunday 14th June**. Same as the practice please give or take an hour or so either side of this time. *Directions: drive through the village of Sheriff Hutton, go past the village hall on your right and continue around the corner, pub is on the left hand side and park in the car park.*

If students struggle with getting to the drop off point there will be a minibus leaving from the Vale of York Academy at 8.30am being driven by myself. I can't fit all students in the minibus, so this will be on a <u>first come first served basis</u>. Students can add their names to the minibus list by ticking the box on the reply slip. Once full, students will need to travel with parents/carers.

The students will be walking from Sheriff Hutton to Coneysthorpe (Castle Howard) on Saturday and returning on a different route to Sheriff Hutton on the Sunday. Although students will be remotely supervised during the weekend, they will be self-reliant and will be carrying all their equipment and food. The students have received training to support them during the expedition and a kit list and menu idea list is attached to this letter for further guidance on what to ensure students bring with them.

Students will be provided with tents, safety and cooking equipment but need to make sure that they have obtained the necessary personal equipment for them to be safe and comfortable (a kit list is attached to this letter for guidance). If any students have difficulties in obtaining these items they need to inform myself as soon as possible so that alternative arrangements can be made.

The total cost for the Bronze Award is £100.00. £40.00 was the signing up fee which went to the Local Authority, with the remainder, £30.00 for the practice weekend and £30.00 for the qualifying expedition.

The £30.00 charge for the assessment weekend covers camping fees, fuel, maps and equipment hire. This should be paid via Parent Pay please. Please return all payments for this expedition to **Mr Rampling by Monday 8**th **June 2020.**
